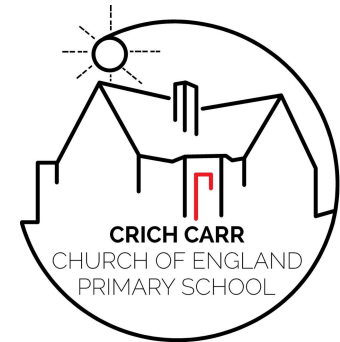

An introduction to our Breakfast and After School Club

School Club offers out of school care for the children of Crich Carr C of E Primary only, offering a variety of activities led by a club supervisor and assistants who are both extremely well qualified and enthusiastic about their work!

Our aim is to provide a 'home from home' setting in our cosy 'school house' which has been totally refurbished and resourced specifically to provide an environment that is different to that of the classroom. In this 'homely' setting we will seek to ensure that children feel happy and secure and are provided with motivational activities which stimulate their minds, improve their knowledge and develop their skills. We also recognise the need for children to have time to relax and unwind: a DVD player is available for short term viewing or for special occasions, and music often features as part of club activities. As in school, the club aims to create a family atmosphere where good relationships between all children and staff are fostered.

For an additional charge children may have breakfast and/or tea (such as toast with different toppings). When your child is in club we will assume that they require a meal **unless** you have advised to the contrary. Meals should be paid for monthly with payments given to either the School Secretary or a member of School Club.

School Club staff plan a variety of activities for the children. Other suggestions from the children are always welcome.

School Club is run by the school and not an 'outside provider'. Being an extension of school all relevant school policies apply to the School Club.
